Delivery of Core GPS Instructional Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● GPS core instructional programs can be delivered in this space. ● Common Planning Time for staff (collaborative instructional planning). 	
Safety, Health and Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Can be remediated with appropriate techniques. ● High level of confidence in secure access to the building. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● There is a perception of health issues at the modulars, although environmental expert testing does not support perceptions.
Delivery of Support Services (ESL, SpEd, Speech, OT/PT, Health, Nurse, etc.) and ALP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Space is available for support services such as ESL, Nurse, Speech & Language, SpEd, Psychologist and ALP. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Limited “work space” for SpEd team.
Delivery of Specials (PE, Art, Music, Media)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Educationally appropriate space is designated in the modulars for art. ● GLENVILLE: A computer lab will be located in the modulars for all grades. ● GLENVILLE/HAMILTON AVENUE: Media space has been designated at WMS. ● GLENVILLE: Music instruction to be delivered as an “in-class” service. General Music teacher has taught in this format in the past. ● HAMILTON AVENUE: Music instruction to be delivered at WMS. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Physical Education would take place off site at the Boys and Girls Club (until March) and the Hamill Rink (March-June).
Administrative leadership and supervision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Informal and formal observations of staff can take place with ease because the school is in one location. 	
Size of classrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provides educationally appropriate instructional space for classrooms K-5 to deliver all GPS programs. 	
Number of Grades	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Keeps the entire school population together. ● Provides a unified school culture. ● Assemblies can take place at the WMS auditorium (brings the whole school community together). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Occupancy for the multipurpose room needs further analysis to ensure the space can accommodate the number of students per lunch wave.
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Existing space for staff lounge/copy room/mailroom. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Limited space for childcare and PTA sponsored “afters” programs.
