	<u><b>GLENVILLE: WGCC</b></u> <b>WGCC:</b> Housing three grade levels (3-5) <b>Two Host Schools:</b> Parkway (K-1) and Cos Cob (2) <u><b>HAMILTON AVENUE: WGCC</b></u> <b>WGCC:</b> Housing three grade levels (2-4) <b>Three Host Schools:</b> Parkway (K), Cos Cob (1) and WMS (5) PreK would remain at current relocation sites (North Street and Old Greenwich)	<u><b>GLENVILLE</b></u> <u><b>*Remediated Modulars:</b></u> Housing 6 grade levels <i>*Keeps entire school community together</i> <u><b>HAMILTON AVENUE</b></u> <u><b>Remediated Modulars:</b></u> Housing 6 grade levels PreK would remain at current relocation sites (North Street and Old Greenwich)
<b>Ability to deliver core GPS instructional programs</b>	<i>Yes</i>	<i>Yes</i>
<b>Level of confidence of facility's health and safety</b>	<i>High; WGCC recently renovated</i>	<i>High with remediation provided by reputable companies; quarterly testing after completion of remediation</i>
<b>Delivery of Support Services (ESL, Sped, Speech, OT/PT, Health, Nurse, etc.) and ALP</b>	<i>Compromised: Will not have adequate space for support service delivery</i>	<i>Yes</i>
<b>Delivery of Specials (PE, Art, Music, Media)</b>	<i>Compromised: Art, Music and Media will be "push-in" unless additional space can be found by dividing up the cafeteria at WGCC for one special (art). Music will be on a cart, a challenge given the multiple floors. There is a PE space on site.</i>	<i>Yes: For Glenville, a full computer lab will be located in the modulars which will cause the Media Center to be located at WMS. Music will be on a cart. Hamilton Avenue will have Music and Media at WMS. Both schools will have Art in the modulars. Both schools will have PE at the Boys and Girls Club and/or Hamill Rink.</i>
<b>Administrative leadership and supervision</b>	<i>Compromised: With two administrators, three to four (or more) sites will prove challenging. The Host sites' administration will need to assist with supervision.</i>	<i>Yes: With all students at one site, leadership and supervision will not be an issue.</i>
<b>Size of classrooms</b>	<i>Estimated: 600-750 sq. ft.</i>	<i>Estimated: 600-750 sq. ft.</i>
<b>Time</b>	<i>Estimated Availability: Tight to make start of school; later than modulars since P&amp;Z approval is required</i>	<i>Estimated Availability: start of school (if allowed an accelerated schedule); no P&amp;Z approval required</i>
<b>Cost</b>	<i>Approximately \$2,000,000</i>	<i>Approximately \$1,000,000</i>
