HAMILTON AVENUE SCHOOL FACILITY AND RELOCATION PLAN UPDATE

Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Betty J. Sternberg:

"I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the outpouring of support for the families and staff of Hamilton Avenue School (HAS) from the entire Greenwich Community and to express my sincere appreciation for their generosity. The staff, students and parents at each relocation site have been remarkable in their flexibility, in preparing classrooms for the HAS students, and in their warm welcome to the HAS community. We would not have been able to implement a relocation plan as comprehensive as this if not for the staff and families from our other school communities – administrators (GOSA), teachers (GEA), support staff, and parents; Town Departments, including the Greenwich Police and Fire Departments; PTA Council; and Community organizations and service providers, including the United Way, Family Centers, the Children's Day Center, the Boys and Girls Club and the Alliance. Finally, while this situation has been very difficult and the relocation of HAS is less than ideal; the administration, staff and families of Hamilton Avenue School have been incredible and I thank them for their patience, support and flexibility during this time. There are many others that have offered their support and we have yet to be able to take advantage of their kind offers – know that we so appreciate your calls and emails. Facilities:

- * IAQ (indoor air quality) test results received to date have been posted to the GPS Web Site. These reports indicate that the indoor air quality is at acceptable levels relative to levels external to the building.
- * Follow up testing to identify the specific **TYPE(S)** of **MOLD** found are expected to be available next week (several tests with staggered culture dates).
- * Per request from the public on Monday, March 3rd, the environmental consultant has conducted tests for **FORMALDEHYDE**. These are expected to be available early next week.

- * Greenwich Fire Department Inspector and Greenwich Public Schools Director of Security, Tom Bobkowski, conducted walk-throughs at each of the relocation schools today.
- * Tom Bobkowski is also working with the Greenwich Police Department to address traffic and safety concerns at the relocation schools for next week.
