RULES FOR DISMISSAL

- ✓ AFTERS classes are held between 3:25 PM - 4:25 PM. Children must be picked up promptly at 4:25 PM in their classrooms.
- ✓ Children not picked up by 4:30 PM will be in the care of the monitor on duty inside by the front entrance and a \$10 LATE FEE APPLIES, immediately and directly payable to the monitor. This will be strictly enforced. If you are late in picking up more than two (2) times, we reserve the right to remove your child from the program.
- ✓ If anyone other than the parent/guardian is picking up the student, a note must be sent in with the child that day.

EARLY DISMISSALS, HOLIDAYS, SCHOOL BREAK

- ✓ There is NO AFTERS during school vacation weeks, on holidays, staff development days and early dismissal days due to inclement weather or parent/teacher conferences.

MAKE UPS

- ✓ There will be ONE AND ONLY ONE make up day due to cancelled classes for any reason, usually the week following the last scheduled class. AFTERS make up days are announced in the green Weekly Bulletin.

ABSENTEE POLICY

For the safety of the children, the AFTERS monitor is responsible for ACCOUNTING FOR ALL THE children that are signed up for AFTERS on any given day. Therefore:

- ✓ The AFTERS monitor will notify you by phone if your child was present at school but absent from AFTERS. If your child is home sick or is sent home during the regular school day, please notify the front office that your child will be absent from his/her AFTERS class.
- ✓ Call the school office at (203) 531-9287 to report any UNPLANNED absences.
- ✓ Send in a NOTE with your child for his/her teacher IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE IN AFTERS on any given day.

REFUND POLICY

- ✓ There are NO REFUNDS or CLASS SWITCHING after the first week of class.
- ✓ There are NO REFUNDS for student absences.
- ✓ There are NO REFUNDS if your child is removed from class due to disruptive behavior.

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR

The AFTERS program strives to be a positive and fun experience for all children. If a student is disruptive or disrespectful to others, the child's parent/guardian will be notified. A second notification will result in removal from the class without a refund.
