Update from the National Honor Society

- Decisions for eligible juniors who submitted packets will be sent through U.S. mail before the end of the school year.
- Newly eligible juniors who reach the 3.55 required GPA after final grades are calculated will be notified in late June. Notification of their eligibility will be via an email to both the student and parents. Students will have access to the on-line packet and will have until the end of September to submit their packet for consideration.
- The induction ceremony will take place in the Performing Arts Center at 7 p.m. on Monday Nov. 4, 2019

From the Guidance Department:

Students are able to download a copy of their unofficial transcript from their Aspen portal. Sometimes a coach, college program, or honor society requests a copy of your transcript, and most often, this unofficial one is all that's required. The Unofficial Transcript report is run from the STUDENT Aspen Portal: My Info tab > Transcripts side tab. Options are "Final", "Mid-Year" and "Current". Credits are awarded and cumulative GPAs are updated at the end of each semester (twice a year). Select "Final" for the transcript that prints your final grades and the credits awarded.

Senior "All Clear" Process - Each graduating senior needs an "All Clear Slip" to pick up their cap & gown. They get this by clearing up all GHS obligations. A list of your obligations (such as text books, athletic uniforms, Senior Internship, Senior Project) are posted outside YOUR HOUSE. Once you gather individual clear slips for each obligation, THEN you return to your YOUR HOUSE and get the All Clear Slip. For students on Senior Internship, the Career Center staff will be available on Friday 6/14 before and immediately after your 1:15 graduation practice to review your hours and journal entries and provide you with an individual slip verifying meeting this obligation. For students completing a Senior Project, you will receive an individual slip during the group exhibition scheduled from 9-11 in the student center on Thursday 6/13. The good news is that the Board of Education (BOE) resolved last month to eliminate styrofoam trays from the school cafeteria by July 1. Unfortunately, the BOE was not inclined to request an interim appropriation necessary to fund dishwashers and reusable trays for the district for the 2019-2020 school year until this option is piloted at New Lebanon School. We will continue to strongly advocate for this pilot to be expanded district-wide. Thank you all for your support to date – parent advocacy was key to getting us this far! We hope we can count on your support going forward and into the 2019-2020 school year for a reusable food ware system - the most responsible solution for our children's health, our environment and the budget!
