### **Discussion:**

#### Menus:

It was noted that standard menus have been developed for October. November menus are to be updated with previously discussed changes.

Menu planning and strategies were discussed.

Food Choices and improvements were discussed. It was noted that processed items are to be upgraded or eliminated completely. Committee members cited specific examples.

### Marketing:

Committee members were advised that Director of Communications, Sasha Houlihan, will collaborate with the Food Services Sub-Committee to communicate to the community key changes in the Food Service menu and program.

### **Update on Trays, Dishwashers:**

The potential need for an additional monitor and cost impact was discussed. Reduction of plastic waste was discussed. It was noted that Food Services will be transitioning to compostable paper for fruit and vegetable cups.
