First Selectman's Youth Commission: For All GHS Students: Applications to the First Selectman's Youth Commission of Greenwich are now open. There are five (5) available positions for Greenwich High School students. To access the application, <u>go to the GHS Website</u>.

Guidance Department:

Mrs. Lochridge, our College & Career Counselor is hosting a "Transition to College" webinar for GHS seniors and juniors on May 14 from 4pm to 5pm. She has a panel of GHS alumni who are current college students. Topics will include living with a roommate, balancing academics with sports and/or clubs, selecting courses, choosing majors, and more! Participants will hear panelists' observations about what it's like to transition from high school to college.

Students taking AP exams are encouraged to access their AP Classroom account for regular updates from the AP Program. Test takers are provided with an exam day checklist as well as videos about technology requirements and what to expect when taking their exams.

Seniors are encouraged to log into Naviance to take the Senior Exit Survey and change their school email address to a personal email address. GHS Guidance also needs seniors to report the results of their college applications to their Guidance AA (Angela Carino in Bella House, Judy Massi in Clark House, Giovanna Vernuccio in Cantor House, Karina Palomo in Folsom House and Rose Furano in Sheldon House). We also need to know each senior's "final plan" so that we can send their official transcript to the college, university or technical program they plan to attend after graduation.
