Please note the following clarifications to the project scope:

- The bid opening date has been extended to Wednesday, 1/15 at 10am. Bids will be opened at this time and date. This information supersedes info provided in Addendum #4.
- Bidders shall treat replacement of the existing condenser water pumps (P-5, P-7) and all associated materials/labor as an Alternate. This work shall be included as a separate line item in the bid (Alternate #2).

The following questions have been asked and answered:

Q1: Backfilling of material excavated needs to be tested for contamination. Who is responsible for that? If determined after testing that it is contaminated where will it need to be hauled away to?

A1: The installation of the (2) 18-inch condenser water pipes will result in excess excavated material that will need to be tested and removed from the site. Bidders shall include cost to test, transport, and dispose of <u>uncontaminated</u> soil in base bid.

Bidders shall also include a unit price (per cubic yard) for transportation and disposal of contaminated soil per local and state regulations.
