These strategies are designed to help students grow as readers, thinkers, collaborators and writers. In addition, students will be taught a variety of executive functioning skills to help them learn how to plan and prioritize tasks, organize their thoughts and materials and reflect on their learning and goals. Students will be exposed to a variety of career and college opportunities, set long term and short term goals and work on progress monitoring.

New Lebanon School (NLS) is an authorized International Baccalaureate World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP). The school has a brand new, state of the art, student-centered building that opened in February 2019, complete with a new media center, gymnasium, cafeteria (offering free breakfast and lunch for all students), playground and other support spaces for children, teachers, and school administration. NLS also offers a robust aftercare program. The magnet program presents the GPS curriculum in a holistic, inquiry-based framework, which makes connections among subject areas with an emphasis on global perspectives. NLS offers world language instruction in Spanish in grades K-5, Teachers College Columbia University Reading and Writing Workshop and partnerships with local community organizations, including the Byram Schubert Library, the Boys and Girls Club of Greenwich, Family First (Family Centers), Horizons at Brunswick and Byram Archibald Neighborhood Center (BANC).

Overview of the Greenwich Public Schools Magnet Application Guidelines

The Greenwich Public Schools (GPS) provides an opportunity for families to choose to send their children to one of four elementary or one middle magnet schools through an annual application process. The GPS magnet program is designed to:

1. provide parents and students with options to personalize educational opportunities based on individual preferences
2. balance enrollment among the elementary and middle schools on a voluntary basis

Programs and Services: GPS magnet schools provide the same curriculum, programs and services as all other Greenwich public elementary/middle schools. In addition, magnet schools offer a particular instructional framework and/or features that are unique to the individual schools.

Lottery Process: Each of the GPS magnet schools is also a neighborhood school, with students enrolled from within the designated attendance area. A limited number of magnet seats are available by application for students residing outside the magnet schools' attendance areas. If more applications are received than there are seats available, a lottery is conducted.

Applicant Eligibility: Any resident of the Town of Greenwich with school-age children is eligible to apply to a GPS magnet school. Non-resident Town of Greenwich (TOG) employees are also eligible to apply to GPS magnet schools; Non-resident TOG applications will be considered after Greenwich resident applications are filled.

Hamilton Avenue School (HAS) is the District's first Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM) school. STEAM education ignites interest and uses an inquiry approach to develop the skills and knowledge that prepares students for expanding college and career opportunities. In a state-of-the-art building, built in 2009, with a design lab, HAS was one of the first two Greenwich Public Schools to launch a Digital Learning Environment in 2012. HAS offers world language instruction in Spanish in grades K-5, Suzuki Violin (PreK-5), and smaller average class sizes in grades K and 1.
