

## Fifth grade Ringing-Out Ceremony – Awards Ceremony

All parents in the school are welcome to come and watch. PLEASE BRING A BEACH CHAIR OR BLANKET TO SIT ON. This is a celebration for our entire school so students in K-4 will sit on blankets at the front of the lawn facing the patio. All parents and families may set up chairs behind the students.

The fifth grade students should be dressed in appropriate attire for the ceremony. We ask for boys to wear dress pants or dress shorts with collared shirts or shirt and tie. Girls should wear dresses, skirts, or dress pants. We ask that that girls refrain from wearing tops with spaghetti straps, halter-tops or strapless dresses. The sitting area for fifth grade students is shaded at 9 am in the morning so a light sweater may be needed. The fifth grade students should also bring a change of clothes appropriate for their fifth grade party that will take place out on the field following the ceremony. Shorts, T-shirts, and sneakers would be best. There will be water games but shirts and T-shirts are required (no bathing suits) and the students should have clothes for changing after getting wet.
