Community Update – April 2018

About the School Building Project

This intra-district elementary International Baccalaureate magnet school will serve students in grades PreK-5. The centrally located learning commons, equipped with flexible furnishings & adaptable technological infrastructure, allows for multiple zones of simultaneous learning. The building is designed to meet the sustainability goals established by the Educational Specifications and to achieve a gold-level LEED rating from US Green Building Council.

The following work was accomplished:

- Rock Crushing is now complete, and the crusher has been removed from the site

Work anticipated for the coming weeks:

- Topsoil Screening on-site will be ongoing
- Foundation Layout and Concrete placement
- Site Excavation and Underground Utilities; Storm drainage
 - Excavation on Richards Street for Sanitary installation has started and will continue for approx. 2 weeks. Residents have been notified and have been asked not to park on the street during this period.
- Structural Steel is anticipated to begin towards the end of the month
- Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment coordination is underway
 - Curriculum and Technology Departments are providing respective comments
