- 1. The meeting convened at 1pm. The agenda was approved by a vote of 3-0.
- 2. Discussion Item: SST Project Manager: Jim Hricay described the process to date and reviewed the RFP for hiring a project manager. The interview committee includes Mr. Hricay, Dr. Carabillo and Mr. Watts. A decision is expected in 1-2 weeks. The consultant will provide a job plan.
- 3. Discussion Item: Future committee work.
 - i. A punch list will be developed by the administration over the next 2-3 weeks. The punch list will include a list of issues to be addressed for optimal implementation of the start time change and each issue will also include a description of its priority level, the lead time required for execution and any need for Board involvement. Board committee members will give their input with regards to issues and prioritization and will invite input from other Board members or other individuals as needed.
 - ii. Each issue will be further described including a framing of the problem statement, identification of those to be involved and who is taking responsibility, and a timeline.
 - iii. Criteria for evaluating solutions were discussed. These included safety, academics, financial, and social emotional considerations including family impact.
 - iv. Examples of issues to be included in the punch list that were brought up at the meeting included: elementary schools for 9am start, field time limitations, academic impact of early dismissal for athletes, and high school students not eligible for transportation.

v. Board Role: discussion of what role the Board and committee can play to assist the administration's work included: sharing issues from the community that are areas of concern, communication with other organisations within Greenwich, prioritization of issues and options for solutions in conjunction with the administration.
