

SURVEY DATA ANALYSIS BY GRADE LEVEL PARENT GROUPS

The following survey data is based upon the analysis of the “Somewhat Positive and Negative” and “Very Positive and Negative” sentiments shared by the various stakeholder parent groups represented in the Start Time Survey conducted in April 2016. Each grade level configuration is highlighted in the table below and combined groups representing more than 50 households are shown as Pre-K and elementary parents only, elementary and middle school parents, elementary and high school parents, and middle and high school parents followed by parents with children in all three grade levels: elementary, middle and high school families.

Over sixty-five percent of all parents that completed the survey identified Option 3 as the start –end time option they prefer the most, with Options 5 and 8 lagging more than 20 percentage points behind as their second and third preference. The top two options rated “Very Negative” and “Somewhat Negative” were Option 6 with 70% and Options 2 and 7, both receiving 64%.

Below is a table of how the grade level band of parents responded to various options on the survey. The table highlights the top 2 or 3 options that were viewed as “Very Positive” or “Somewhat Positive” AND “Somewhat Negative” or “Very Negative” for each group or combined grade level groups.
