The School Readiness Council's Vision

All children in Greenwich will achieve and maintain optimum wellness and will be ready to learn with ongoing access to quality supports and services that ensure school success for children birth to eight years of age.

The School Readiness Council's Mission

All Greenwich children receive quality well visits and developmental screening

All Greenwich children have access to quality preschool experiences

All Greenwich children are supported in their smooth transition into Kindergarten

The Greenwich community is supported in its understanding of the years of early childhood, from infancy to age eight, including best practices in early childhood education

To achieve this mission, the SRC

Provides Greenwich families with access to information regarding community resources available to young children

Hosts early childhood community forums or families and early childhood educators

Studies the impact of quality early childhood education and experiences on closing the achievement gap

Gathers data on early childhood issues through focus groups and other means

Implements the Greenwich Early Childhood Blueprint

Strategizes with Early Childhood Centers and the Greenwich Public Schools to provide a seamless transition between preschool and kindergarten

Collaborates, plans, and secures funding for timely, topical, professional learning opportunities for Greenwich early childhood educators that enhances professional practice

Secures a School Readiness Grant to fund two School Readiness classes and meet all grant requirements

Identifies and communicates early childhood needs to the Superintendent of Schools and the President of the United Way
