Greenwich High School is offering students in grades 10, 11 & 12 the opportunity to take the **ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery)**. Students must be between 16 and 22 years of age at the time of testing. GHS graduates are welcome to take this test.

What is the ASVAB? It is an aptitude test that helps identify a variety of skills and competencies. It consists of 8 short individual tests covering General Science, Math Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, Math Knowledge, Electronics Information, Auto and Shop Information, and Mechanical Comprehension. Test takers receive scores on each of these individual tests, as well as results combined for three career exploration scores: Verbal Skills, Math Skills, and Science and Technical Skills. These scores can be compared with the educational and job requirements for occupations of interest to students. Taking the ASVAB is in no way a commitment to join the military. However, a student may wish to use his/her ASVAB results as part of an enlistment conversation with a military recruiter.

If you have any questions about the ASVAB, please speak to your house school counselor or the College and Career Center counselor. Space is limited. Priority will be given to seniors, and generally on a first come-first served basis. If you are interested in taking the ASVAB, register as soon as possible by delivering the bottom portion of this announcement to the College and Career Center.
